| 4383 | STOCK TRAFFIC SURVEY RESULTS The survey results were read out to the Parish Councillors which revealed some interesting results. The 2018 results showed that the volume of cars passing through the village has hardly changed since the previous survey which took place in 2014. The average daily speed is 30.2mph. And 29.8% of vehicles exceeded 30mph which is less than 2014. The results also showed that the speeds throughout the hours of 7am to 7pm were very consistent | <i>ALL</i> |
